
WOOD LIVES



Growth characteristics, structure, knots, and grain tell this story, making each one unique. The tree rings especially reflect the seasons and climatic conditions. At HIRAM Habitat, we sort according to the knotting, grain, and color of the wood. We manufacture our wooden floors in up to three different gradings, creating a harmonious overall picture for every project.

TYPES OF CONSTRUCTION

SOLID WOOD PLANK

The HIRAM Habitat solid wood plank is the classic among plank floors. It consists of a single piece of wood directly from the trunk of the respective tree. It has all the advantages of pure natural wood and is particularly durable and high-quality.






ENGINEERED PLANK

The engineered plank from HIRAM Habitat is the perfect alternative for an exquisite real wood floor. The plank consists of three layers that are pressed together with high-quality adhesives. The top veneer layer can be sanded multiple times and is in no way inferior to the conventional solid wood plank. Its reduced thickness has advantages, for example, in combination with underfloor heating, allowing heat to rise more easily through the floor.







GRADING



URBAN CLASSIC

The premium "Urban Classic" grade consists of nearly knot-free and partly pin-knotted planks. The color structure and grain of the wood are calm, providing an elegant and timeless spatial effect.



COUNTRY CLASSIC

The "Country Classic" grade is a natural grade with knots, shrinkage & wind cracks, and slight color differences in the wood. Indoors, the "Country Classic" grade creates a harmonious sense of space.



RUSTIC CLASSIC

The "Rustic Classic" grade looks lively and includes predominantly dark-filled knots and longer hairline cracks. The wood surface appears vibrant due to the natural color variations. With the appropriate surface treatment, the wood creates a cozy room atmosphere.

NATURAL WOOD PRODUCT

HIRAM Habitat planks in solid wood and three-layer construction are high-quality natural products made from local wood. We recommend using experienced parquet layers for installing these large-format planks, as construction projects can have different requirements. A constant room humidity is crucial for installing wooden floors. Wood reacts to climate fluctuations, swelling with increasing and shrinking with decreasing humidity. The solid planks have a residual moisture of 8 - 10% the engineered planks 7 ±1 %, and room humidity should therefore remain between 40 - 65% throughout the year. Strong fluctuations can lead to movements in the wood, causing cracks and warping in the floor. During the heating season, the wood releases moisture, which can lead to gaps between the planks. These usually close again in summer. In case of uncertainty regarding the room climate, using a hygrometer is advisable to take appropriate measures for creating better climatic conditions.

INSTALLING ON UNDERFLOOR HEATING

Gluing our planks onto screeds with underfloor heating is possible, even though the heating generally dries out the wood a bit more. Artificially generated heat can occasionally cause slight cracking in the core area and small gaps between the planks. Generally, the thicker the plank, the longer it takes for heat to penetrate the wood. Thus, the energy input is somewhat higher for the solid wood plank than for the three-layer plank. Another aspect is the formation of gaps; the solid wood plank moves a bit more due to the artificially generated heat and thus forms minimally larger gaps. The three-layer engineered plank is more dimensionally stable due to its construction (middle layer and counterbalance layer of spruce). They should also be fully glued to the screed. The heating screed protocol must be followed. We recommend coordination between the heating technician and parquet layer, and checking the screed and wood moisture before installation.

CARE OF SURFACES

For the proper protection of HIRAM Habitat products, we recommend initial treatment with oils, soaps, or hard wax oils. We also offer a factory finishing. These finishing systems protect the surface particularly effectively, as both the wood pores and the surface are protected, while the wood can still breathe and retains its natural properties. A high-quality natural wood floor treated with one of the mentioned systems is generally easy to maintain, but should be regularly cared for to ensure the wood remains beautiful for many decades.
